
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


- Let escape the excess pressure of the hydraulic tank (open the ventilation filter)
- Mount a vacuum pump instead of the ventilation filter, create a vacuum.
- Turn up the bellow 8 at the pilot-operated valve.
- Screw out the 4 hexagon socket screws item A, remove the complete lever with retaining plates.
- Pull the leaking tappet set **10** out of the housing.
- Check the seat surface in the housing B for scratches, damage, etc.
- Press in the new tappet set10.
- Remaining assembly analogous. (The lever must nearly be free from play, if need be, readjust pressure disk C).




- Let escape the excess pressure of the hydraulic oil tank (open the ventilation filter)
- Connect a vacuum pump instead of the ventilation filter, create vacuum
- Turn up the bellow 4 at the pilot-operated valve
- Unscrew the handle 3 together with the cardan joint 7 and the remaining parts
- Pull the leaking tappet set 8 out of the housing
- Check the seat surface in the housing 6 for scratches, damage, etc
- Press in the new tappet set 8
- Remaining assembly analogous (lever must nearly be free from play, if need be, readjust pressure disk 5.

- Let escape the excess pressure of the hydraulic oil tank (open the ventilation filter)
- Connect a vacuum pump instead of the ventilation filter, create a vacuum
- For the work to be carried out now, e.g. replacement of hydraulic lines, all ports have to be plugged. Do not interrupt the vacuum pump operation
- Turn up the bellow (12) at the pilot-operated valve
- Slacken the nut (11) with fork wrench 19 mm
- Unscrew the handle (5) together with the bellow (12)




 Before slackening the cardan joint (3), unscrew the cover (22) from the seat console




 Unscrew the cardan joint (3) by means of a hexagon socket screw key (A) 8 mm


• Hold the housing as, otherwise, it will drop



 Pull the housing (10) out of the retaining plate (2)





- Pull the leaking tappet set (9) out of the housing
- Check the seat surface in the housing (10) for scratches, damage, etc.
- Press in the new tappet set (9)
- Remaining assembly analogous (lever must nearly be free from play), if need be, readjust pressure disk (5)
- Pay attention to the colour marking when tightening the nut (11)!




- Let escape the excess pressure of the hydraulic oil tank (open the ventilation filter).
- Connect a vacuum pump instead of the ventilation filter, create a vacuum.
- Turn up the bellow (12) at the pilot-operated valve.
- Slacken the nut (11) with a 19 mm fork wrench.
- Unscrew the handle (5) together with the bellow (12).
- Unscrew the cardan shaft (3) by means of an 8 mm hexagon socket screw key (A).
- Remove the shims and the holding plate (2).

- Pull the leaking tappet set (9) out of the housing.
- Check the seat surface in the housing (10) for scratches, damage, etc.
- Press in the new tappet set (9).
- Remaining assembly analogous (lever must be nearly free from play, if need be, readjust pressure disk (5)).
- Pay attention to the colour marking when tightening the nut (11)!







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
